

Regional Roadway Network (RRN) Criteria

1. Transportation facility or service is included in:
 - Strategic Intermodal System (SIS)
 - National Highway System (NHS)
 - State Highway System (SHS)
2. Transportation facility or service is identified as a regionally significant roadway in the Strategic Regional Policy Plans adopted by a regional planning council or regional planning organization.
3. Transportation facility or service is part of the region's economic development infrastructure and provides linkages to regional activity centers or designated as a regional freight mobility corridor.
4. Transportation facility is existing or future roadway that serves areas of significant economic and tourism activity (i.e. beach areas, shopping malls, etc.).
5. Transportation facility or service serves as an existing or future evacuation route as designated by the appropriate regional planning council.
6. Transportation facility or service provides direct connections (existing or future) to the Strategic Intermodal System (SIS) (including emerging facilities) and serves as an integral part of an interconnected regional network.
7. Transportation facility is existing or future roadway that serves as a reliever to the SIS or other regional arterial roadways.
8. Transportation facility or service crosses county boundaries.
9. Transportation facility is functionally classified as a principal arterial on the Federal functional classified system.
10. Transportation facility or service is used by a significant number of people who live or work outside the county in which the facility or service is located.
11. Transportation facility or service is an intermodal facility not on the SIS.
