IV. MCAT Quarterly Report

Mr. Bill Steele and Mr. Ryan Suarez, MCAT, reported on the following:

- Discussed the fixed route bus service modifications that will be effective as of November 12, 2016.
- MCAT started (last month) a pilot program for the Medical Bus Pass Program. Customers will be required to qualify for the program in order to receive an unlimited day pass to ride the fixed route bus to medical appointments and back home.
- MCAT's ADA bus stop upgrades and improvements are working on 9th Avenue East and 27th Street East in Bradenton.
- MCAT will move into the new facility located on the corner of US 301 and Tallavast Road by November 12, 2016. There will be a ribbon cutting for the new facility in January, 2017.

V. SCAT Quarterly Report

Mr. Chris DeAnnuntis and Mr. Rocky Burke, SCAT, reported on the following:

- Discussed the fixed route bus service modifications that will be effective as of November 12, 2016.
- SCAT stated there will be changes to the Liberty Pass Program starting October 1, 2016; there will be an increase per month from \$8.00 to \$15.00; on October 1, 2017 it will increase from \$15.00 to \$20.00 and in 2018 it will be phased out.
- SCAT is moving forward with a design build approach for the ADA bus stop upgrades.
- SCAT is working on putting WiFi on all buses.

VI. FDOT Update

Mr. Richard Shine, FDOT, reported on the following:

- Introduced the new FDOT Transit Liaison, Pamela Barr.
- FDOT was approved for a \$132,000 Grant to work with Sarasota County on Sarasota Hospital land for a Park and Ride on I-75 and Sumter Boulevard.
- FDOT will be holding Grant Funding Workshops for the 5310, 5311, and 5339 grants on October 26, 2016 in Bartow from 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. and October 27, 2016 in Fort Myers from 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.

• FDOT is preparing for the end of the state Fiscal Year.

V. MCAT & SCAT Transit System Updates

Mr. Chris DeAnnuntis and Mr. Rocky Burke, SCAT, reported on the following:

- SCAT will be presenting the Final Comprehensive Operations Analysis (COA), the Liberty Pass Public Hearing tentatively scheduled for September, 2016 and the new Fiscal Year budget to the Sarasota County Board of County Commissioners on July 12, 2016.
- SCAT is putting 10 new buses in services.

Commissioner Linda Yates was disappointed in SCAT for not providing any updates on the Comprehensive Operations Analysis process. She feels that the Commissioners were not given a chance to review the documents and make comments. Mr. Chris DeAnnuntis stated the documents were on the website and could have been reviewed at any time. Councilman Bob Daniels stated the Commissioners should have the documents provided to them instead having to go to the website due to the Commissioners busy schedules.

Mr. Bill Steele, Mr. Ryan Suarez, and Mr. Jim Egbert, MCAT, reported on the following:

- Skyway ConneXion: It was implemented on April 1, 2016 to take passengers between Bradenton and St. Petersburg/Pinellas County-Bay Pines Hospital.
- Service Modifications:
 - o Improve frequency on Route 3 (Manatee Avenue) and Route 6 (Cortez Road) to every 30 minutes.
 - o Restructure Route 99 to operate between Downtown Bradenton and Downtown Sarasota and to ensure 30 minute service to and from the Palmetto Station.
 - o Restructure Routes 1, 13, and North County ConneXion to improve Downtown Bradenton connections with 30 minute frequency.
 - o Restructure Route 4 to improve connections to Blake Hospital from Downtown Bradenton.
 - o Modify Route 6 service east of DeSoto Station to Lakewood Ranch Boulevard.
 - o Longboat Key alternative service delivery concept.

- o Eliminate some early morning trips on the Anna Maria Island Trolley.
- o Eliminate unproductive Saturday service on Route 9.
- MCAT's ADA bus stop upgrades and improvements are working on 9th Avenue in Bradenton. A total of 121 shelters have been installed to date and 295 pads have been poured.
- Universal Access Pass Agreements: This program is a three-party agreement between Manatee County, Sarasota County, and two local colleges (Ringling College of Art and Design and New College of Florida). The agreement allows students, faculty, and staff to ride Manatee County and Sarasota County fixed route bus service for free when presenting a valid College issued ID.

- Commissioner Linda Yates stated she would like to have quarterly reports at the PTTF meetings, like the ones that were provided in the past. Mr. Jim Van Pelt stated he would get with Mr. Rocky Burke to provide the correct documents for all future meetings.
- Mayor Shirley Groover Bryant stated she is really impressed with MCAT's public outreach.
- Mr. Jim Van Pelt stated he visited Ride Rights facility and the technology they are using is very impressive. There is hope that they will improve on service provided.
