Mr. Tim Roberts, FDOT, provided a demonstration on the new Signal 4 Analytics site which affords the ability to pull crash data information that has previously been provided by the LEL Team. He demonstrated how easy it is to navigate the site and how it shows information in emphasis areas regarding the Strategic Highway Safety Plan for FDOT, serious injuries and fatalities, annual numbers compared to previous years back to 2018, the day of the week, hours of the day, and the age group. This platform now allows everyone to pull information and may be accessed at https://signal4analytics.com.
